FUNDRAISING

As I mentioned a few months ago, in order to do everything we typically want to do, we need to raise between \$300-400 annually. Membership dues will cover some of that, but we will need to do other activities as well.

- We have brought up the idea of doing **Yard Sales** instead of Flea Market sales. However, we need to set up the dates and locations.
- We have also discussed the **Amazon Associates** program, but after

 - d) get approved by Amazon.

With this program, we will have a link to our website to Amazon's, giving us up to 15% of the profits without costing the *Continuum* anything to do it.
